

ORDINANCE NO. 2008-6

**An Ordinance amending Chapter 10. Traffic and Motor Vehicles  
Adding Section 10.56 Restricting Parking in Residential Areas.**

**Be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Oregon, Ogle County,  
Illinois.**

**Section 10-56.**

**WHEREAS**, certain issues have arisen concerning the propriety of types of vehicles being parked in the areas of the City of Oregon which have zoned residential; and

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities of the City of Oregon have provided opportunities for residents of the municipality to provide input into the issue raised; and

**WHEREAS**, the corporate authorities have studied the issues which have been raised and now make the following finds;

1. Truck owners and operators provide a valuable service to the City as well as to its economy.
2. Parking or standing of certain units in residential areas of the City creates safety issues due to decreased visibility.
3. Parking or standing of certain units detract from the aesthetics of the residential neighborhoods in the City including, but not limited to odors and noises emanating from the vehicles.
4. Parking or standing of certain units cause damage to the roads and alleys in the residential neighborhoods.
5. It is the best interests of the City of Oregon to restrict the parking and/or standing of certain units in the areas of the City which are zoned residential.
6. The units to which the restrictions apply are truck tractors, recreational vehicles, vehicles with a gross weight rating in excess of 16,000 lbs., camping trailers, semi trailers, recreational trailers, construction trailers, any other trailer, or any equipment that is towed.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY OF OREGON, OGLE COUNTY, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:**

**Section A.**


1. Truck tractors, semi tractors, or any combination thereof will only be allowed to park on the street or alley in a residential district for pickup or delivery purposes only.
2. Restricted units other than truck tractors, semi trailers, or any combination thereof will be allowed to park on the City Street in a residential district from 6:00 A.M to 8:00 P.M.

**Section B.**

The penalty for violation of any provision of this Ordinance shall be that which is prescribed in the fine section of the Oregon City Codes.
